Excerpts of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9994 (Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010) that took effect July 6, 2010

Article 12. Utility of Discounts

Section 1. The grant of a minimum of five percent (5%) discount relative to the monthly utilization of water and electricity supplied by the public utilities: *Provided*, that the individual meters for the foregoing utilities are registered in the name of the senior citizen residing therein: *Provided, further*, That the monthly consumption does not exceed one hundred kilowatt hours (100 kwh) of electricity and thirty cubic meters (30 m³) of water: *Provided, furthermore*, That the privilege is granted per household regardless of the number of senior citizens residing therein;”

To avail of the discount under this section, the senior citizen shall:

- Apply for the discount personally or thru a representative. There shall be annual renewal of the application to the utility provider.

Section 2. Fifty (50%) Discount- The grant of 50% discount on all electricity, water, telephone consumption, all DSWD-accredited senior citizens center and residential care institutions or group homes that are government run or organized and operated by non-stock, non-profit domestic corporation, primarily for the purpose of promoting the well being of abandoned, unattended or homeless senior citizens.

Such senior citizens center and residential care of group homes must have been in operation for at least six (6) months and must have a separate meter for said utilities/services.

Section 3. DSWD shall issue the necessary guidelines within (30) days from the affectivity of this rule for the accredited senior citizens center and residential group homes willing to avail the utility discounts.

The Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), The Metropolitan Water Works and Sewerage System (MWSS), the Local water utilities Administration (LUWA) and other concerned utility-regulated agency shall, within six (6) months after the effectivity of these rules, formulate supplemental guidelines to cover recovery rate mechanics and or sharing or burden, among other concerns of the distribution utility.

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The implementing Rules and Regulation took effect July 6, 2010. However, we cannot yet implement the said discounts in the absence of the supplemental guidelines to be formulated by the energy Regulatory commission (ERC). These guidelines are very important. This will guide the cooperative in computing the correct discount and how it will be recovered. In the meantime, we are accepting applications of qualified senior citizens as mandated by this Rule. Applications forms are available at all MOPRECO Offices within the franchise area.
